Past Revisit	Find out about forests around the world. What is the forest called? Where is it located? What is the climate like? List some animals and trees found in the forests.	Design a healthy meal for someone who will be hiking through a forest. The food must be nutritious, easy to carry and tasty to eat (cold!).	Take some photographs of different plants that can be found near to your house. Can you identify them? Can you name and describe the different parts of each plant?	Create a story map that retells a story from the Bible.
Present Consolidate	Find out about the different types of Roman Gladiators. Name the different kinds, draw them and describe what they used in the arenas.	Design your own Roman mosaic picture. You could use pens, paint or pencils. You could even cut up tiny pieces of paper and create a collage.	Draw some pictures or take photographs that show a force in action e.g. push, pull, twist etc	The Romans worshipped a number of Gods and Goddesses. Find out the names of at least 4 Gods/Goddesses.
Future Ignite	Find South America on a map. Which countries are in South America? How long would it take to get to South America from the UK?	Create a pencil sketch of a rainforest. Try to include lots of detail e.g. show the different shaped leaves.	Find out about an unusual animal that lives in the Amazon Rainforest. Name them, explain what they eat and describe what they look like.	Tell us what you are looking forward to doing in year 4. You can write it down, draw it or create a video presentation.
